

## 2004 \ 2005 Jr Elks Membership Drive



In order to encourage growth and participation, the following membership drive contest will kick off at the October, 2004 Jr Elks meeting.

This contest will be points based and the prizes will be awarded as follows:

- 1 – 1<sup>st</sup> Place Prize: \$100 Toys R Us or Mall Gift Certificate
- 1 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Place Prize: \$50 Toys R Us or Mall Gift Certificate
- 2 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Place Prize: \$25 Toys R Us or Mall Gift Certificate
- 10 – 4<sup>th</sup> Place Prize: \$10 Toys R Us or Mall Gift Certificate

The awards will be presented at the Kids Camp Out on June 18, 2005. The contest will go until May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2005.

Plus each month, starting in November 2004, a random drawing will be held for a \$10 Toys R Us gift certificate. In order to be eligible, you must be present at the monthly Jr Elks meeting when the drawing takes place.

Points can be earned as follows:

New Member Attends Monthly Meeting	5 (Max. 25 per new member)
New Member Attends Jr Elk Activity	5 (Max. 25 per new member)

In addition, the advisors will give out various activities that can be done at home to earn additional points. A list of these activities will be handed out at each month's Jr Elks meeting. The points will vary from each of these activities.

Here are a few items to start off the list:

1. Write an essay (25 –50 word minimum) on what it means to you to be an American. (20 Points)
2. Participate in a Veterans Day Memorial Activity on November 11th (20 Points)
3. Bring an item in for the November Food Drive (5 Points)
4. Bring an item in from the Jr Elks Giving Tree (5 Points)
5. Bring an item in for the December Food Drive (5 Points)
6. Write letter to soldier (5 Points Each, Max 25 Points)
7. Memorize the Star Spangled Banner (20 Points)
8. Help clean up kids playground at lodge (10 Points – Fall & Spring)
